Minutes of Club Meeting May 4, 2008

Old business:

Upcoming field repairs for the north end of the runway were discussed. A field work day has been scheduled for May 18th.

A motion was made by Mark Woytassek to spend up to \$500.00 if needed for runway repairs. It was seconded by Randy Cady, voted on by membership present-motion passed.

Mark Woytassek questioned the possibility of changing the design of the starting stands at the field to conform more in line with AMA standards. Mark will try to find a design plan for the suggested stands.

A reminder that club training starts May 7th, Wednesday night at 6:00 pm. The helicopter pilots have been training on Monday nights, but we do not know if they are planning on training again at that time this year.

The Tri-Hawks event date was confirmed for June 26th to June 28th, Friday to Sunday. This will be at the Waterloo Blackhawks' New Hartford field. Skyhawks members were encouraged to participate in this event. Next year's Tri-Hawk event will be at the C.R. Skyhawk's field. Wendell had the Blackhawks' event schedule and mentioned a few of their activities.

Wendell informed members of the upcoming Cedar Rapids Freedom Festival costs. The Freedom Festival participation fee is \$200.00 plus the required AMA

special insurance cost of \$30.00. We missed the entry deadline of the end of February to enter this year. Next year's participation will again be a possibility if the club so desires.

Larry Brewer commented that Freedom Festival activities at the Skyhawks field might compromise our field privacy and security.

Show and tell:

Van Winegarden brought his new acquired treasure, the Skynight 6, a 70's kit of a .60 sized pattern plane made by Kitty Hawk Models of Indiana.

Wendell commented about a very good book he's been reading lately by the author David Thornburg called "Do you speak model airplanes?"
