Meeting closed at 7:40 pm.

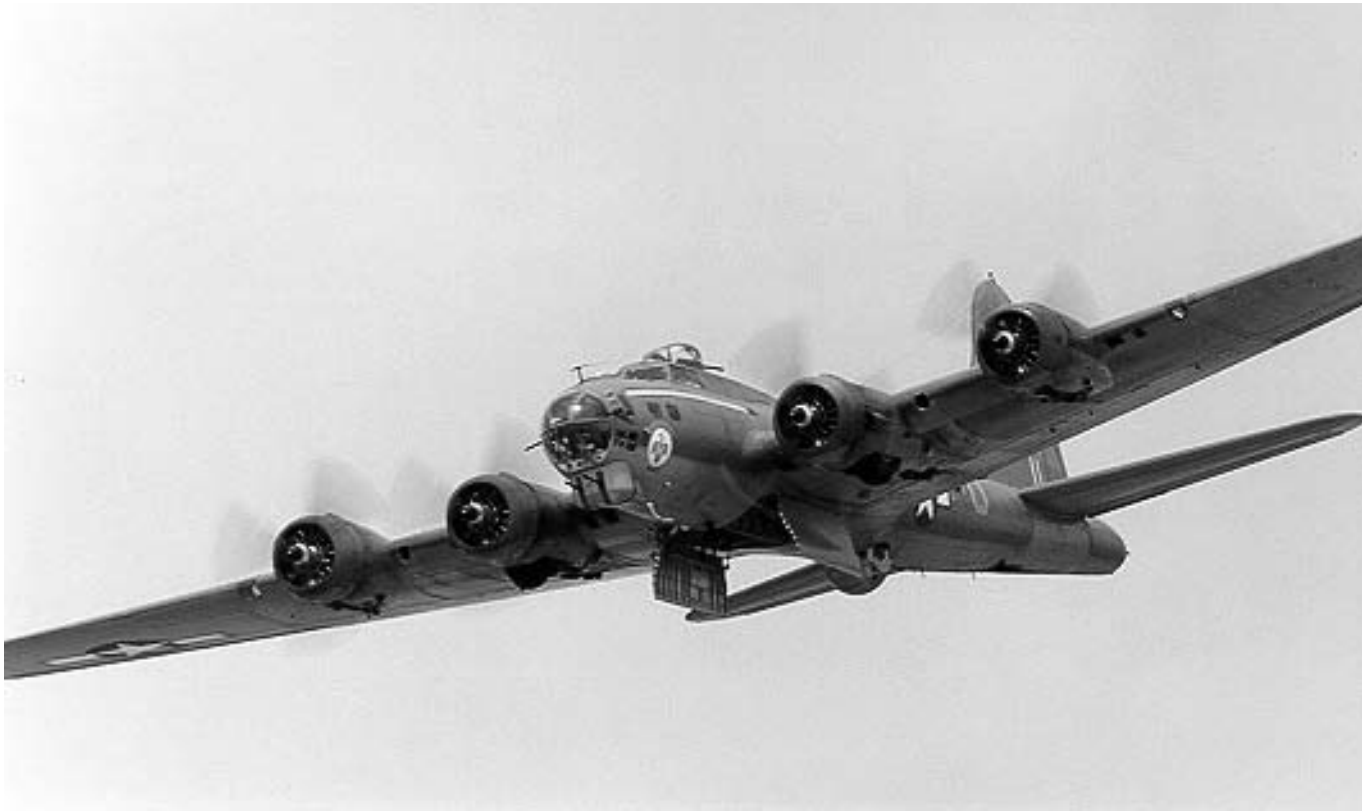
Show & Tell:
