Skyhawks Meeting Minutes

9-8-2024

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Todd Davis with 14 members present.

Treasurer's report: One new member bringing the total membership to 64 including 10 Life members. Expenses paid for Port O John rental, field maintenance and second half field lease.

The August meeting minutes were read and approved.

Old Business:

No update from the city regarding the ADA project. It may be a project for next year..

Todd was contacted by a member of a local flower club. They have interest in converting the house at our flying site to a pavilion including flower beds and walking trails. This would be very expensive and the cost would be an issue. Todd told the individual we lease our flying site and their interests would not be compatible with our flying field operations.

The city removed the dead tree adjacent to the field entrance as requested.

New Business:

Mark Woytassek stated that drone incursions continue to be a problem with the FAA issuing more fines. Drone use is severely restricted in Canada. He referenced the projected growth in northeast Cedar Rapids and recommended we plan for future field development. He also stated there were some prop strikes at WOI that should be repaired, we should have a response plan for downed aircraft at events and that we all should be enforcing our safety rules.

Don Rosendale stated the Quiet Flyers will have a Swap and Fly Saturday, September 14 at Seminole Vally Park. The swap event is not limited to electrics.

The Skyhawks Swap and Fly will be on Saturday, September 21.

Jim Wittkamp was welcomed as a new member. Because he was joining late in the year Mark Woytassek made a motion that his dues payment also include membership for next year. Seconded by Steve Wilson. Motion passed.

The Club has received a Sig LT 40 ARF as a donation from a former club member. It is in excellent condition and has an Avistar 46 engine and Futaba servos. We do not have a club member learning to fly who could use this aircraft at this time so it will sold in a silent auction with all proceeds going to the club. Todd will email details to club members.

Show and Tell:

Matt Mulbrook brought a couple of Lanier Shrike 15 aircraft. One electric and one glow powered built from a kit. The electric has an upgraded motor, is lighter and flies better.

Don Rosendale brought a Lidl Flyer, a foam glider converted to electric. It was available at Menards for about \$9.00 but is out of stock now. It is still available on Amazon. It has a 34 inch wingspan and weighs 9.6 oz. Flight Test A radial power pack components are used. It uses a 650mah 2 cell pack for 5 minute flights. There is a Lidl Facebook group forum. Don has instructions available for the modifications he made.

Don also brought an Elipstik that he restored and recovered. He 3D printed some of the parts and added ribs. It has a 41 inch wingspan and requires at least a 125 watt motor. It is built largely from $1/8 \times 1/4$ balsa strips. Don has plans available from a Jon McVay build.

Jim Buttleman demonstrated a carrying device he built to transport his Top Flite B-25. He can carry the plane like a suitcase, even up and down stairs. He did maintenance on the engines, improved the wiring and added a Bombay.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 PM.


