## **Skyhawks Meeting Minutes**

### **February 2, 2025**

Todd Davis called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. There were 12 members present.

Jim Doty gave the Treasurer's report. 1 family membership was received, and the AMA charter and insurance was paid.

We currently have 27 paid members for 2025 including 9 life members.

David Logan read the minutes from the December meeting.

#### **Old Business**

- **Banquet** The annual banquet was held on January 11, 2025 at the Starlite Lounge in Cedar Rapids. It was well attended, and all attending seemed to have a good time discussing current projects and past flying experiences.
- Membership Badges The membership badges have been prepared for 2025 and will soon be printed. Some of the pictures that were used for the badges were those taken on the photo day that we had last Fall.
- ADA Work We still have no word from the city on the ADA work or when they plan to start it. Our old contact with the City of Cedar Rapids has left her post and we do not yet know who our new contact is or will be.
- **Iowa City Aerohawks Swap Meet** Some club members attended the swap meet in Coralville recently. It looked like they had a good turnout.

#### **New Business**

- Warbirds over Iowa The date for Warbirds over Iowa has been set for Saturday, August 23, 2025.
- Electric Fly We plan to host an Electric Fly event. The tentative date is July 19, 2025. This will not be a sanctioned AMA event, and it hasn't been well attended in the past.
- New Path Mowed at Airfield Randy Lepsch was out at the field recently and noticed that a path has been mowed down just West of the pit area going East to West along the tree line that borders the house and sheds. We have no idea for what purpose this has been done, but it is suspected that the city may be planning a controlled burn of the area. Steve Wilson commented that he had noticed that the grass has been mowed down along the entire perimeter of the field.
- **Drone Activity Report** Mark Woytassek mentioned that a drone hit a Canadian firefighting aircraft that was battling the recent LA wildfires. The drone damaged the wing of the plane and took it out of commission for any further firefighting. The drone weighed less than 250 grams, so it was exempt from the FAA registration requirements. The person flying the drone has been apprehended.
- Cedar Rapids Dog Park (A.K.A. Cedar Rapids Skyhawks-Lippisch Field) Mark mentioned that he has seen a several people who are using the airfield property as a place to let their dogs off the leash to run and exercise. We discourage this behavior due to the liability and because we lease the property, and this has not been approved by the club.
- Name That Plane Todd Davis presented several pictures of model aircraft from the past that our club members have flown, and we were asked to identify the owner of the plane. All were recognized and identified correctly by individuals in the group.

#### **Show N Tell**

Matthew Mulbrook brought in his flourescent red Sig Something Extra that he purchased at the Ankeny Swap Meet before Christmas last year. The plane weighs about 5 pounds and is equipped with an O.S. .46 AX nitro engine.





Todd Davis brought his C&C Aermacchi M346 turbine jet model he recently finished. He used the same turbine that he had in his F80 that sadly was lost last year. He sent the engine in to the manufacturer and they looked it over and gave it the thumbs up for his use. The turbine is a Jest Central Cheetah 160 with 36 pounds of thrust. It has a 77 inch wingspan and is 90" in length. It weighs about 33.5 pounds. He also installed the light kit.





David Logan brought in a handy sanding tool he purchased at Menards for about \$10. It is a foam sander and works great for sanding countours and fillets.
