Skyhawks Meeting Minutes

July 13, 2025

Todd Davis called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. There were 15 members present and 1 guest.

Jim Doty gave the Treasurer's report. There are now 53 paid members for the 2025 season. David Logan read the minutes from the June meeting and the minutes were approved.

Old Business

Mowing – The city has been mowing, but Duane has continued to mow in the pit area.

Warbirds over Iowa Port-O-Potty – A second port-o-potty has been ordered for the week of the Warbird over Iowa event.

Warbirds over Iowa Planning – The sanction request was submitted to the AMA and was approved. The event should appear in the next issue of the Model Aviation magazine. The event has also been picked up as a KCRG "Show You Care" event, since the proceeds of the event go to the Honor Flight organization. Todd passed out flyers for the event at the Iowa City Aerohawks airshow earlier today. Todd is currently working on a T-shirt design for the event. He mentioned that all club members helping at the event will receive a free T-shirt. He asked for opinions on color. No decision was made but white, light blue, or gray were suggested as they would be cooler. We will discuss volunteer needs and event details in more depth at the next meeting, which will be the last meeting before the event.

Electric Fly Event – The Electric Fly event is next weekend (July 19).

Field Rolling – Since we've received a good deal of rain recently, a roller was rented over the weekend to roll the field and the grass runway. Todd Davis, Steve Wilson, and Duane Lupia went and got it, rolled the runway, and will return it on Monday.

Runway Caution – Please do not walk on the runway when it is very wet. The gravel underneath gets very saturated, and footprints sink into it permanently, causing dangerous divots in the surface.

Field Improvement Committee Report – David Logan reported that the Field Improvement Sub-Committee has met and has begun to research some of the proposed ideas.

New Business

Unauthorized Partying at the Field – The week before Independence Day, it was discovered that someone had hosted a party in the driveway leading to the field. The sheds were broken into, and wood was burned in the driveway. Several beer cans were strewn about the area as well. Some have suggested we put a gate up, but we are required to leave the drive open to allow farmers to gain access to their fields.

Deer Trail in the Sumac – Steve Wilson said that he has discovered that the deer have made a pretty decent trail through the sumac down to the creek. It begins in the outfield near the white marker pole.

Show N Tell

Gary Owen shared an experience of powering up his Carbon-Z T-28 from idle to full power quickly and shattering his electric motor. He has gotten it replaced but shared the cautionary tale. He didn't mention at first that he has an overpowered ESC and a three bladed prop on the stock engine but nonetheless be cautious of powering up too quickly.



Don Rosendale brought a couple foam airplanes that he bought from Amazon. He cut the empennage out of one and moved the tail section forward. He employed a method of using steam from boiling water followed by rapid cooling to straighten the bend in the end of the wings. He then installed a receiver and small Flight Test A pack motor. Using a 2 cell lipo, he is able to get 4-5 minutes of flight time.
