Skyhawks Meeting Minutes

June 1, 2025

Todd Davis called the meeting at the airfield to order at 7:03 pm. There were 14 members present.

Todd Davis gave the Treasurer's Report in Jim Doty's absence.

• Current membership payments for 2025 is 49.

David Logan read Minutes from the May 2025 meeting.

There was one correction to the Minutes as read mentioned by Todd Davis. Where the Minutes stated, "any permanent structures or utilities would have to remain if we ever ended the lease or had it terminated by the city" should be stricken from the record and replaced with the statement, "any structures or utilities constructed or provided by the club shall be removed by the club at the termination of the lease."

Old Business

- Mowing Todd Davis said he would contact the city in the next week to determine whether they will continue mowing for us.
 Wendell Makestaad said that if we do it, the city may think that we are now doing the mowing instead of them and may discontinue mowing. While many mentioned that the pit area is looking good thanks to Duane Lupia coming out to cut the grass in the city's absence, it was stated it would be in the club's best interest to let the city take care of it.
- Membership Badges If you have paid your dues, be sure to pick up your 2025 membership badge from Todd.
- Lone Tree Fun Fly Lone Tree will be hosting a Fun Fly on June 12-13. AMA membership and TRUST certificate is required to fly. Lone Tree club is located not to far from the Riverside Casino.
- AMA Altitude Restrictions Randy Lepsch clarified that though the AMA has increased our altitude limitations from 400' to 700' in cooperation with the FAA, the club is required to get a letter of approval from the AMA to so. Todd Davis said he has received that letter and will forward it to Jim Doty, Treasurer, for filing with other important club records.

New Business

- Drone Incursions Mark Woytassek stated that drone incursions still are occurring though they are not being published. Some
 state and local authorities are cracking down on illegal drone use. He stated that there are some really nice and expensive
 drones being confiscated at our National Parks where it is illegal to use drones.
- Woytassek Flight Log Mark also shared that as of the date of the meeting he has already logged 984 minutes of flight time.
 He had hoped to hit 1000 minutes by now but fell a little short.
- Flyers for Events Randy Lepsch said if we have flyers for the upcoming events, he can publish them on the Skyhawks website. Todd Davis stated that he would make flyers for the Warbirds Over Iowa event to pass out at the upcoming Aerohawks Demonstration Day in Iowa City. He mentioned that David Logan has a printer on which we could print some nice flyers and would reimburse him for paper and ink.
- First Aid Kit David Logan mentioned that our first aid kit and supplies needs to be updated and replenished. He said he
 would take care of it.
- Unauthorized Access to the Field Mark Woytassek shared that he has notice an increase in the number of vehicles that are
 coming to the field, locking up the brakes and leaving once noticing that someone is present.
- **Donations Left at the Field** Please do not leave items on the picnic tables or anywhere else at the field that you wish to "donate" to the club. While you may think it may be useful to someone in the club, and it gets it out of your garage, the club then must dispose of it should no one take it. This is a financial burden we do not need. If you have items you wish to give away, it is better to post their availability through the Skyhawks Facebook page.
- Runway Maintenance If the right conditions present themselves, we will rent a roller to smooth out the runway. It is getting a little bumpy and could use the work if it is not too soft or hard to get good results. Todd said we would keep an eye on things and act in a timely manner if the proper conditions are there. He also mentioned that we will be having a field maintenance day sometime before Warbirds Over Iowa.
- Warbirds Over Iowa Wendell asked if we were planning to do plaques or trophies for WOI as we have in the past. Todd said he would look into getting awards that look nice but don't cost much. We typically give awards for best flight, pilot's choice, etc. Todd said he has submitted the Warbirds Over Iowa event for recognition as a "Show You Care" event for KCRG. He also said he will be submitting the AMA sanctioned event request this month.

There were no items brought to the meeting for Show N Tell.
